## Louisville KY July 5-11 2011

This location appears to be a premiere spot for the students and sponsors who attend. The city of Louisville has worked very diligently in trying to make this time exceptional for all attendees. During our tour of the city and facilities in which we will be using and staying, we had a comforting sense of safety. The safety of our students has become a large concern for us as a district and we plan on making this event just as safe. The majority of the events we will be participating in will be within about a seven block walking distance.

The first question we all ask when the talk of NYC comes around is "how much is it going to cost?" NYC 2011 will cost each participant \$1275.00 (this includes both students and sponsors). This price includes registration, lodging, transportation, food, and entertainment. We promise that as plans are finalized, if we are able to lower prices, we will do so. We will begin accepting the registration fee of \$450.00 on September 1 and you will have until November 26 to remain at that registration price. Anyone who registers after November 26 will have an additional fee of \$75.00 and after January 3<sup>rd</sup> you will have an additional \$75.00 for a total late fee of \$150.00. Due to our commitment to the general church and to the other businesses we are working with, there will be NO MONEY REFUNDED at any time. This is just registration prices. Keep in mind that all funds must be in full by April 1, 2011. Your church and the participants have almost a year to make this happen.

Some local churches may be looking at NYC and thinking we don't have a sponsor to send. That's OK. As a safety policy we are only looking for a 1 sponsor to 8 student ratio for the entire district. Also the district council and NYI coordinators are working very closely with the NWO NYI zone presidents in getting all your students to NYC. ## Frequently asked questions

### What is Nazarene Youth Conference 2011 – A World Unbroken?

Nazarene Youth Conference (NYC) is a life changing event for high school students that occurs only once every four years. Through dynamic speakers, worship, breakout sessions, concerts, and more, participants will experience the transformational power of God, understand the brokenness in the world, discover effective ways to respond to this brokenness, and engage in the work of God to bring hope and healing. What's more exciting than thousands of high school students and youth workers from Canada and the United States worshipping, serving, and learning together?

### When and where is it?

NYC 2011 will take place July 5-10 in Louisville, KY. Events will be held at the Kentucky International Convention Center (KICC) and Downtown Arena.

Louisville is just the right city for a conference such as this – downtown Louisville is a friendly, safe, walkable city with the KICC, Downtown Arena, restaurants, and attractions just minutes from the hotels. NYC will begin with regional gatherings on Tuesday evening and a Ministry With Others (MWO) on Wednesday. A kickoff service takes place Wednesday evening and the week continues, jam packed with workshops, plenary sessions, regional excursions, exhibits, concerts, and more. NYC will close with a Sunday morning service on July 10 (due to the length of the travel we will not return till July 11).

**More traveling plans will come at a later date.**

### Who can attend NYC 2011 – A World Unbroken?

- Any student who is going into high school in 2011 (yes, incoming freshman can attend), currently enrolled in high school in 2011 – plus all those who graduate high school in 2011.
- Adult District Sponsors (AGE 21 OR OLDER) must be approved by our district NYI leadership as well as undergo a background check to attend. The preferred adult to student ratio is 1:8. **EVEN IF YOU CANNOT SEND A SPONSOR PLEASE CONTINUE TO PREPARE YOUR STUDENTS AND CONTACT US.**

### What is the cost?

The total cost will be \$1275.00 per participant. The deadlines for when money is due are as follows

Deposit 1 due between September 1 and November 26 (Late fee after November 26 \$75.00)	\$450.00
Deposit 2 due between November 27 and January 3 (Late fee for 2 <sup>nd</sup> payment after Jan.3 \$85.00)	\$425.00
Deposit 3 final payment due by April 1	\$400.00

**NO ONE will be allowed to register after February 4, 2011**

**Money will NOT be refunded at any point.**

### How do I register?

- Students: Your registration will go through the district coordinators. All necessary forms can be downloaded at [www.nwonyi.com](http://www.nwonyi.com)
- Adult District Sponsors: All your forms will be available through the district website ([www.nwonyi.com](http://www.nwonyi.com)). Once your form is completed it must be approved by NWO NYI leadership and you must undergo a background check. Once approval has been given, sponsors will receive a web address from NWO NYI leadership to register on line.
